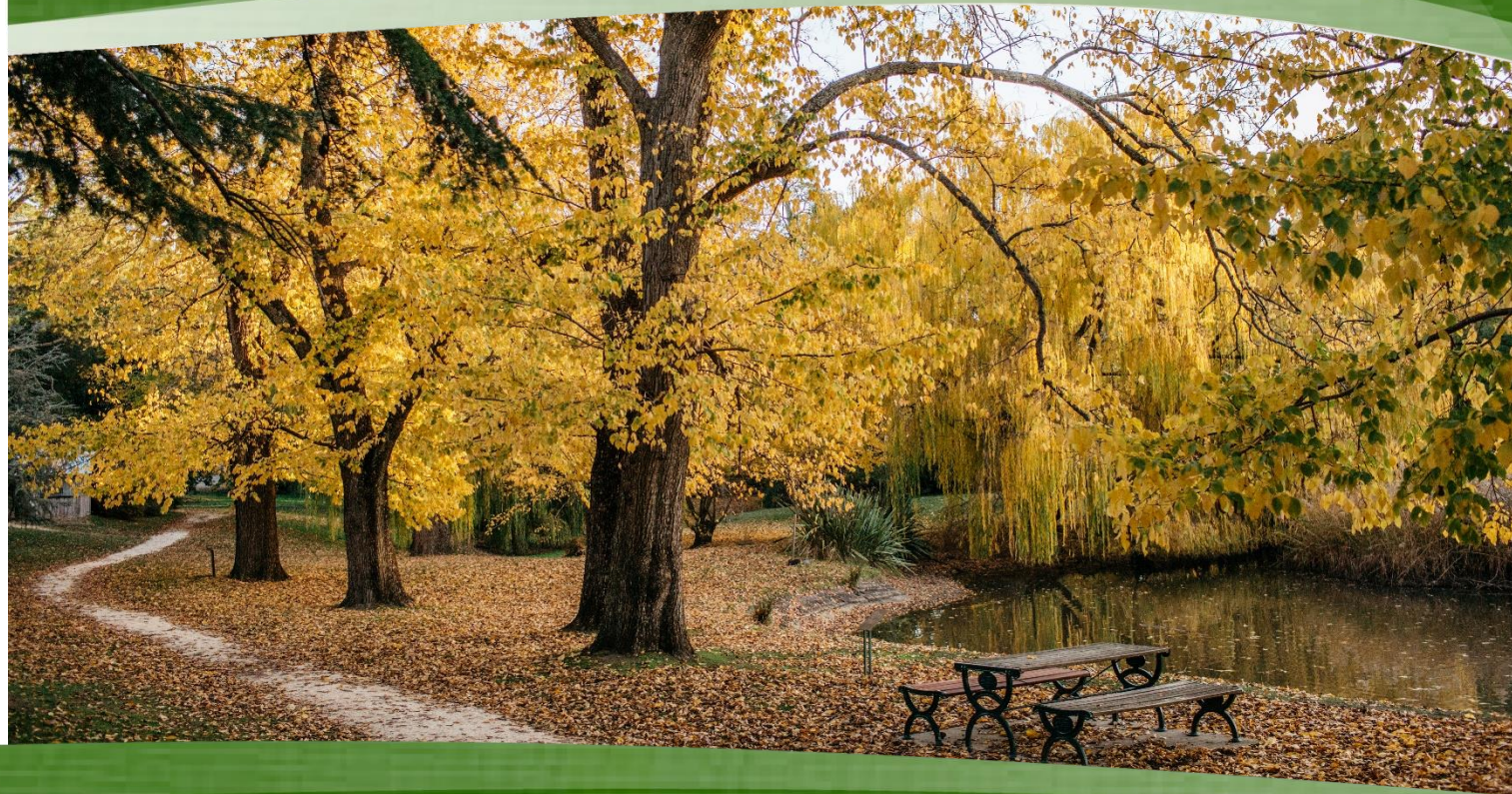

Bringalbit was first settled in 1858 and is a unique part of Australia's rural history. The setting, in the Sidonia Hills, fifteen minutes from Kyneton, is stunning. The huge old trees, 1890's ornamental lake and gardens provide a rare mood of peace and tranquillity.

Peacocks, ducks, chickens, guinea fowl, wild birds, Suffolk sheep and Highland cattle are a feature of the farm. The garden rambles through ten acres of parkland with stone walls and steps, box parterres and new plantings revealing many surprises. Open weekends 10am-4pm or by appointment.

Entry \$10 for garden and homestead, \$5 garden only.
